

Users can log in via email or QR code to connect to Teams and Outlook, with safety as a top priority — for example, only audio mode is available while driving, ensuring drivers can stay connected without compromising road safety.

To comply with safety regulations, FORVIA implemented driver restrictions following Android's guidelines to limit interactions in the application while maintaining essential controls during ongoing calls. For instance, meetings switch to audio only and reading chats or emails are not available while driving.

In addition, FAA is excited to reveal that Al-assisted voice commands and Gen Al based functionalities for increased productivity will be introduced soon as an option.
